

SQUARE LASHING




DIAGONAL.

START WITH A TIMBER HITCH AROUND BOTH SPARS. TAKE ROPE ACROSS AND MAKE TURNS AS SHOWN. THEN MAKE FRAPPING TURNS AND FINISH WITH A CLOVE HITCH.—NOTE! PULL ALL TURNS TIGHT.


Sheer Lashing



SHEER— MARK 1 & 2.

MARK 1. START WITH A CLOVE HITCH AROUND ONE SPAR. FOLLOW UP WITH ABOUT 10 TURNS WITH ABOUT 10 FRAPPING TURNS. DONT PULL TIGHT AS THIS LASHING IS USED FOR SHEER LEGS~ SEE INSERT.~ END WITH A CLOVE HITCH.



MARK 2. START WITH A CLOVE HITCH AROUND BOTH SPARS FOLLOW WITH TURNS FINISH WITH A CLOVE HITCH. WEDGES MAY BE USED TO TIGHTEN THIS LASHING— USED FOR JOINING SPARS AS IN FLAG POLE BUILDING.
